

Move students through guided instruction

The purpose of a scaffold:

- Provides support.
- Functions as a tool.
- Extends the range of the worker.
- Allows the worker to accomplish a task otherwise not possible.
- Aids the worker when needed.

Close reading scaffold, listed in order:

- 1. Ask text-dependent questions to check for understanding.
- 2. Nudge with prompts that focus on background knowledge.
- 3. Hint with cues to shift attention to specific sources.
- 4. Provide direct explanation and modeling to re-teach.
