You will need:

A text of any kind (print, visual, multimodal)









Emotional Reactions





Lingering Questions Other Viewpoints

Recipe for Making a Synthesis



Read the text. Continually check for overall understanding. Use the Stop & Say Something strategy to retell/summarize.



Be on the lookout for **important** parts, lines, or quotes. Pause to ponder them.





Consider if you have any related thoughts.

- Add in background knowledge.
- Add in setting & context.
- Add in emotional reactions.
- Add in **other viewpoints**.
- Add in **genre considerations**.
- Add in **lingering questions**.





Mix together your summary with your added thoughts. Combine them all together and think about what it means. Take a few moments to ask **Why does this** matter? What are you realizing?





Add textual evidence to support (or decorate) your initial synthesis. Present your complete inference (synthesis with support) in writing.
