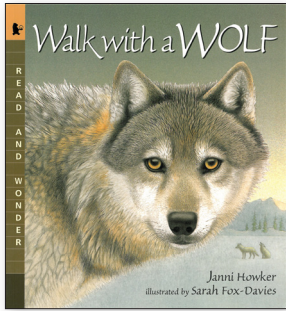

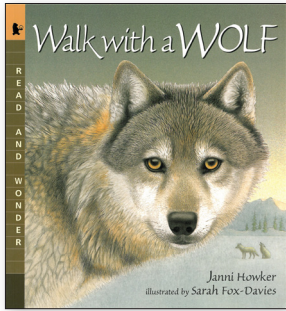
Step 4: **Write/Type**
