





Focus on implementation

A customized follow-up service, the Remote Coach is a fully-“Smekensized” literacy expert who utilizes video conferencing technology to connect with teachers after a Smekens training. By extending the professional development with coaching and support, teachers are better equipped to implement best-practice literacy strategies with fidelity.

Help teachers succeed

A single coaching session will address questions and clarify previous training. But in order for sustainable implementation to occur, teachers need a guide that is available for the entire journey. Consequently, the Remote-Coach service is designed for short, regularly-scheduled coaching sessions with groups of 1-6 educators from the same school.

During each 30-60-minute session, the Remote Coach can engage teachers in focused conversations to celebrate progress, address questions, and plan next steps. To make participation worthwhile, schools are encouraged to commit to a minimum of 10 hours of remote coaching during one school year.
