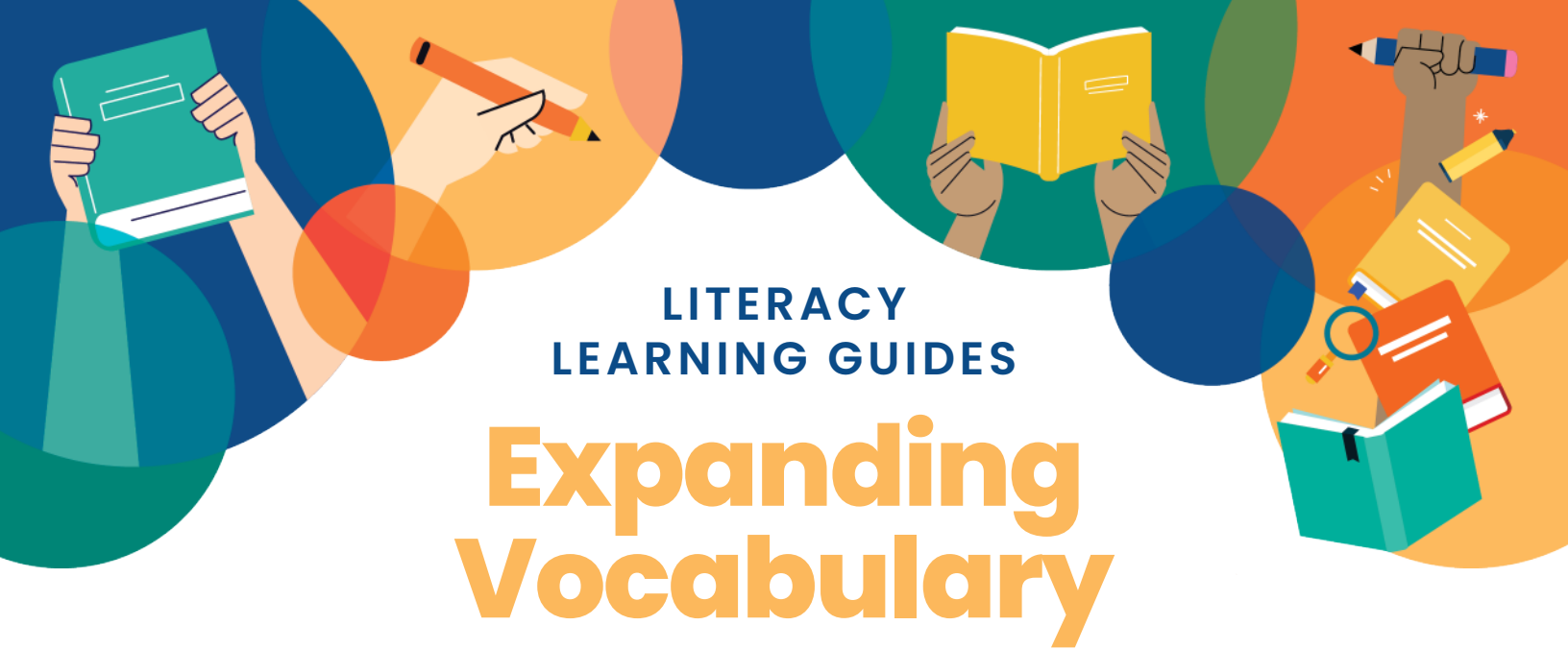

Expanding Vocabulary



For students to accurately use a word in writing, they first need to hear it, see it, and say it in context.



The average student needs to work with one new word 14 times before he masters its meaning.
