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Inferences & Evidence

- Answer literal and interpretive questions using textual evidence.
- Make inferences about texts and use textual evidence to draw logical conclusions.

R2 Text Variety & Range

- Comprehend increasingly complex literary texts.
- Comprehend increasingly complex informational texts.

R2.1, 2.3 Main Idea & Theme

- Retell/Identify a text's main idea with key details.
- Summarize/Paraphrase a section's main idea.
- Sequence events within a text.

R2.2, 3.3, 3.4 Relationships & Development

- Analyze/Compare and contrast textual details to distinguish genres.
- Answer *who, what, where, when, and why* questions about the text.
- Find/Describe examples of literary elements & literary devices.

R3.1, 3.2 Purpose, Perspective, & Point of View

- Identify the roles and purposes of the author, illustrator, and narrator.
- Acknowledge different character viewpoints.
- Evaluate the effects of point of view and perspective.

R3.5 Argument (Fact & Opinion)

- Locate and categorize facts.
- Distinguish between fact and opinion.
- Investigate facts for accuracy.

R3.6 Text Structure & Organization

- Describe/Analyze the structure of texts.

R3.7 Text-to-Text Comparisons

- Compare and contrast texts and ideas within and between texts.

R4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4 Words & Phrases

- Use word parts (e.g., affixes, roots, stems) to define unfamiliar words.
- Use context clues to determine meanings of words (e.g., literal, multiple meaning, domain-specific, and figurative words).

- Compare how ideas and topics are depicted in a variety of media and formats.
- Analyze the impact of selected media and formats on message and meaning.

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
