PURPOSE

A thesis statement announces the topic and main point of the paper.

PROOF

A thesis statement is an opinion that you intend to back up.

CONTROVERSIAL

A thesis statement is arguable/debatable.

NARROW DOWN TO A **THESIS STATEMENT**

IN ONE SENTENCE ...

1. Identify the subject or issue.
2. Narrow the topic to a specific focus (to be proven).
3. Give an opinion. Take a stand. Convey a feeling.

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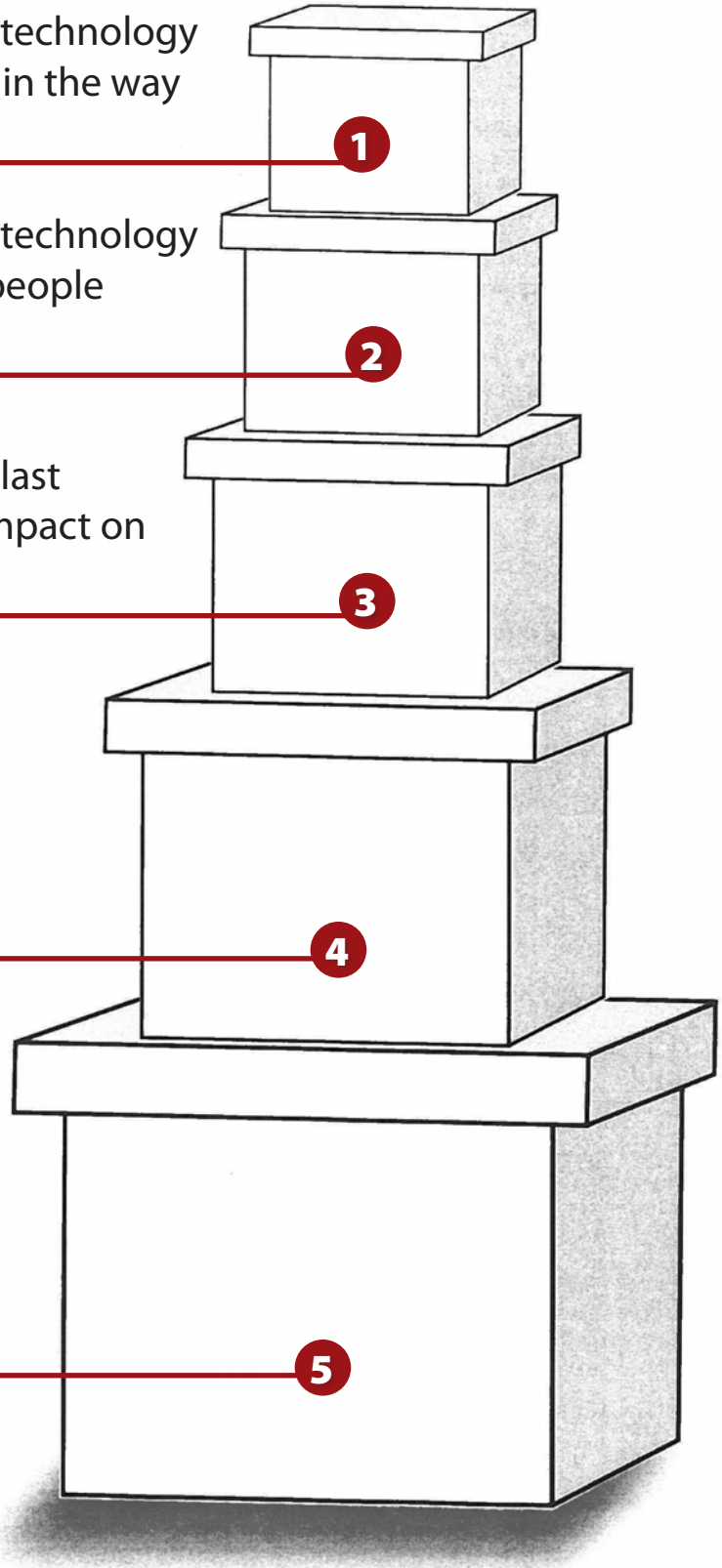
Over the last 20 years, changes in technology have made a profound difference in the way American students communicate.

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5 Broad thesis statement:
Why are there so many high school dropouts in the U.S.?

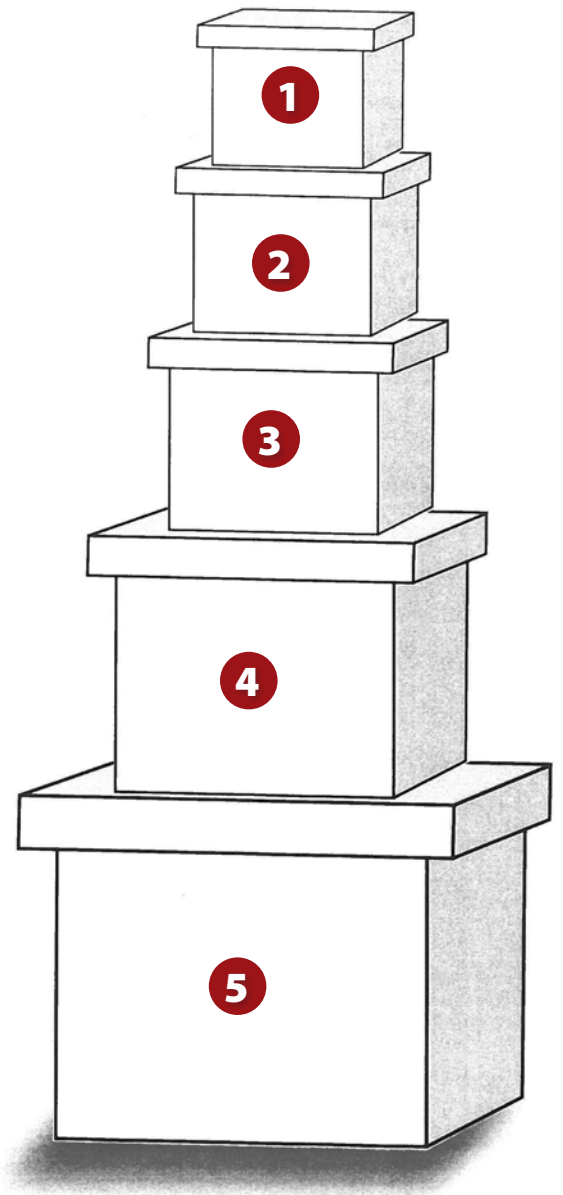
1 Narrow thesis statement:
Grades in high school should be eliminated because they cause anxiety and put unnecessary pressure on students resulting in an increased dropout rate.

5 Broad thesis statement:
This paper will explain why the government has the right to limit free speech.

1 Narrow thesis statement:
The government has the right to limit free speech in cases of overtly racist or sexist language because failure not to suggests that our society condones such ignorant and hateful views.

5 Broad thesis statement:
People need to stay healthy for several important reasons.

1 Narrow thesis statement:
Students must get sufficient sleep at night in order to success in school.
